NOPA fuses architecture, interior, and product design with some seriously lush landscaping—and a retractable glass ceiling in the back. Local design office Autoban created bespoke lighting and furniture for the space while borrowing colors, materials, and textures from nature. They selected the stone flooring for its varying tones, which form a continuous geometric pattern throughout. At the rear, the soundtrack, so to speak, for the open-air dining room is composed by an actual waterfall and the velvety green walls of a vertical garden. The bar, which runs the length of the interior and then slips outdoors to coil into an island, is NOPA'S focal point and recalls the new leather interior of a classic convertible with the top down.
